The Resort

Expect to be lulled by the sounds of ocean waves and the water lapping against the river banks at the Bentota Beach Hotel. Designed to resemble an ancient Dutch fort by the famous Geoffrey Bawa, it is situated at the point where the Bentota River flows into the Indian Ocean. Tranquillity awaits you in all the unexpected places, amid 11 acres of bliss.





Location

Situated 64 km from Colombo, in the Southern coastal zone of Sri Lanka; Bentota is known for its broad golden beaches. If the idea of a vacation calls to mind an image of lazing around on the beach, indulging in mouth watering delicacies and returning home with sun kissed skin, Bentota is the perfect holiday destination.



Layout

The main building of the hotel houses the reception, main restaurant, bar and the main conference hall which overlooks the garden and the sea beyond. The Deluxe Rooms, Superior Rooms and Suites are located in the main building and the Standard Rooms are located in the North and South wings of the main building. The resort is bordered by the sparkling Indian Ocean and the translucent waters of the lagoon.





Rooms

105 Standard Rooms(310 sq. ft.) located in the North and South wings opens out to a view of the luxuriant garden or the still lagoon. The bedrooms adorned with handloom tapestries is equipped with modern amenities and a private balcony or terrace with stunning views.

In the main building 15 Superior Rooms,(300 sq. ft.) open out to a view of the azure Indian Ocean. Sombre shades of the bedroom are lit up with the colours of the setting sun.

15 Deluxe Rooms(385 sq. ft.) provide a comfortable living area and a lavish bedroom, decorated with locally carved wooden masks, painted with intricate designs.



Suites

The Frangipani (830 sq. ft.), located on the top most floor of the resort offering a wide angle view of the surroundings, where the sea flows into the lagoon. A plush bedroom and a spacious living area decorated with the many colours of the sun opens out to a balcony.

The Lotus (830 sq. ft.) offers breathtaking views of the Indian Ocean and lagoon, be lulled by the sound of the rolling waves and retreat to space lit up by the rays of the sun.

The Alamanda (830 sq. ft.), situated in the corner of the top most floor, this suite offers a stunning view of the sea and consists of a large bed room, a living area and en-suite bathroom.
